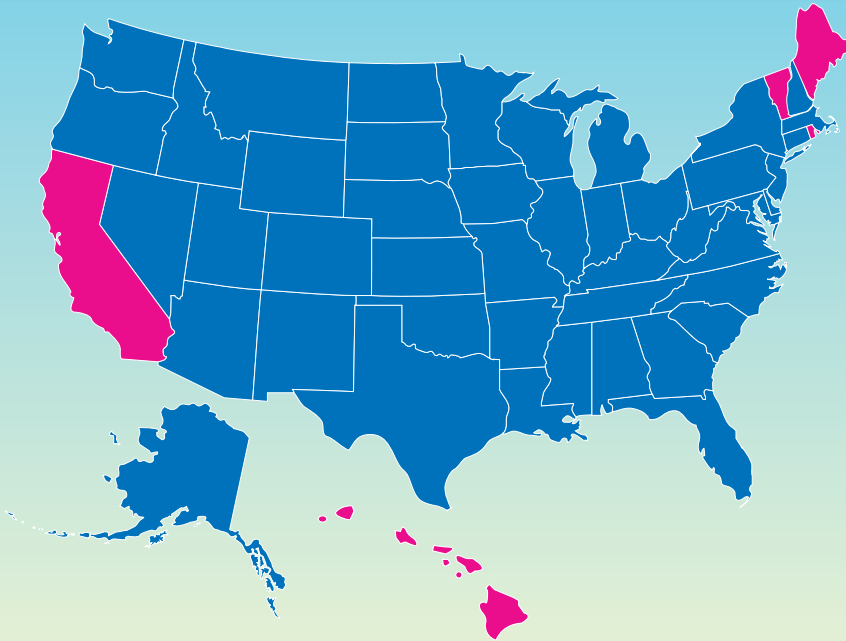


WORST PLACE IN THE U.S.A.
